Code of Conduct

All Band children are expected to conduct themselves at a high standard of behaviour and application at all times. This is especially important during visits to other schools, excursions, or when performing in their own school environment.

Children are to attend all rehearsals with their instrument during the school week.

Band members are to attend band every Wednesday 1.20-1.45 and Thursday 2.00-3.00pm. Band members are to bring their instrument to every rehearsal.

Children are to be respectful and obedient to their peers and the band directors at all times.

They are required to listen carefully and not disrupt other band members.

Children who fail to follow the rules of the band.

Students who fail to follow the band rules will be given a verbal warning. If a child receives two warnings the parents/guardians will be notified by letter. If a third warning is given it will result in a short suspension and an interview with their parents/guardians and School Principal. If this situation is not remedied then they will be required to leave the band.
